The team earned the gold medal in the Halton Catholic Athletic Association (HCAA) Oakville Municipal Tournament after scoring 31 goals and winning 5 games on May 30. The championship match was 4-0 against St. Nicholas with goals from Ciofani (2), Mastroieni, and Novosel.

The team earned the silver medal in the Ecole Forest Trail (EFT) Halton Invitational Tournament after defeating 5 teams from Oakville, Burlington, and Milton on June 12. The championship match was a 4-2 defeat against St. Brigid with goals from Da Silva and Murillo.

The team earned the bronze medal in the Halton Catholic Athletic Association (HCAA) Systems Tournament. The team qualified with the top 2 teams from each municipality and ranked 3rd out of 46 schools on June 17. The team won the bronze with a 6-1 win against Ascension with goals from Hoyle, Ciofani, Terlizzi, Da Silva, Murillo, and Mastroieni.

The team earned the gold medal in the North Oakville Invitational Tournament after scoring 17 goals and winning 5 games on June 19. The championship match was 3-0 against St. Andrew with goals from Ciofani, Da Silva, and Murillo.

The team earned the gold medal in the Oakville Indoor Female Challenge Tournament after scoring 13 goals and winning 4 games on December 11 and 12. The championship match was 6-1 against St. Joan of Arc with goals from K. Thresher, Hoyle, Ciofani, Da Silva, Ceolin, and Mastroieni.

The team earned the gold medal in the OSC Winter Super Cup Invitational Tournament after scoring 32 goals and winning 7 games on December 17. The championship match was 7-1 against St. Joan of Arc with goals from K. Thresher (2), Hoyle, Da Silva (2), Ceolin, and Mastroieni. Ciofani, Da Silva, and Mastroieni were selected to the tournament all-star team.
